



The council moved the goalposts - Bellway Homes called on Baxi Group

Baxi Group's specification and renewable teams and New Design department worked together with Bellway Homes and plumbing and heating contractors M & N Heating to help them comply with a late amendment to planning permission for a site of 286 apartments in Fenney Stratford, Buckinghamshire. Milton Keynes Council required that 10 per cent of the energy demand came from a renewable source.

Potterton Promax SL boilers were installed in conjunction with Baxi Solarflo solar thermal domestic hot water systems. Each apartment has its own flat plate solar collector panel, either incorporated into the tiled roof or on an A frame on an area of flat roof. It also has a Heatrae Sadia Megatech twin coil water storage cylinder and solar controller.

With a SEDBUK efficiency of 91.3 per cent, the Potterton Promax SL is one of the most efficient heat only boilers available on the market and is slim enough to fit inside a standard kitchen wall unit.
