

Potterton secure major 150,000 home contract

Potterton have won the largest single social housing contract to come from the newly formed housing consortium, GM Procurement Limited. The decision was based upon a number of factors including product reliability, efficiency and service support.

GM Procurement, the housing consortium for housing associations and local authorities for 150,000 social housing properties in North West England, chose Potterton as its partner for the supply of gas fired boilers for the contract due to Potterton's track record of supplying quality products to the social housing sector.

The contract is for the supply of Potterton Promax System HE Plus and the Potterton Promax 28 HE Plus Combi boilers.

The project is part of the redevelopment of housing stock to meet the Decent Homes Standard, and through the installation of the High Efficiency SEDBUK Band A Promax HE Plus boilers will also help alleviate fuel poverty.
